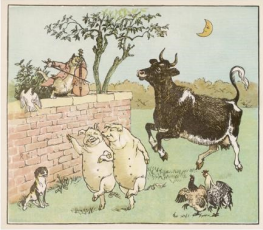


## EARLY LITERACY TIP NURSERY RHYMES
